This Order has made it a legal requirement for ALL funeral directors to publish a 'Standardised Price List' as well as an Additional Options Price List . This has been ordered in an effort to make it easier for the bereaved to compare 'like for like' funeral options from funeral directors - both small and large companies and assist them in their choices.
